

HOUSING OPTIONS IN SAN FRANCISCO



We recommend you stay in one of the many attractive neighborhoods of the city near the « financial district », and close to the campus if possible. INSEEC SF is located at 180 Sansome Street, just a minute from Montgomery St. metro and train station.

IMPORTANT : never book and pay in advance an accommodation from France (except for the listed hostels and student residencies) because you may end up in a dodgy neighborhood and/or get a scam. This is why we suggest you to book a room in a hostel or on Airbnb for the first days upon your arrival, so you can find and pick directly on-site a room in a safe residency or apartment.

Here is a list of housing option recommendations from previous INSEEC students. Please contact the different places directly via email or phone to find out about availability, price, amenities, conditions... The #1 housing option INSEEC students have recommended is renting a room in a hostel or student residence, so you have everything onsite, sometimes breakfast is included and you get a chance to meet with international students. **CAREFUL!** Every student residency has its own policy and may not offer short-term lease. Be aware of the conditions and policy before signing and giving a deposit. This is also applicable to any accommodation arrangements made with a landlord. Remember to ask if the utility and internet connection are included in the rent.

Price range for a shared room: \$700-\$950, price range for a private room: \$1100-\$1600 per month

Downtown San Francisco includes the **Financial District** where INSEEC SF campus is located, the **Union Square** and the **Embarcadero/Fisherman's Wharf**. Other iconic neighborhoods such as **North Beach, Chinatown, South of Market, Nob Hill, Haight-Ashbury, The Castro, Mission District...** are safe and all well connected to downtown SF.

N.B.: we do not recommend living in the **Civic Center** neither the **Tenderloin** districts. Home to San Francisco's City Hall and surrounded by equally important-looking buildings, Civic Center is known to become seedy after sunset. Be prudent after dark!
